(Questions to guide you: Habitat: Where does it live? Food: What does it eat to survive? Friends &amp; Foes: Does it help other animals/humans? Does it have any predators? Superpower: Can it glow, swim, fly or talk?)</li><li>● <b>Elaborate</b> your story in the class after school re- opens and explain why your creature is special.</li></ul>

3. The assignment should be done in the Project Book / Scrapbook. Write your name, grade and heading of each topic in the Project.
