Rules for Writing:

- Word Limit:
 - **Grade IV:** 120-150 words
 - **Grade V:** 150-180 words
- The story must follow the given theme and selected sub-theme.
- Include a clear beginning, middle, and ending.
- Avoid copying from books, the internet, or others.
- Maintain neat handwriting and proper formatting.
- Use proper punctuation and paragraphing.
- Students must express ideas in their own words.



Judging Criteria (Common for Grades IV & V):

- **Content & Creativity** (10 Marks)
 - Original ideas and imagination
 - Interesting storyline relevant to the theme
- **Organization** (10 Marks)
 - Clear beginning, middle, and ending
 - Logical flow of ideas
- **Language & Vocabulary** (10 Marks)
 - Appropriate word choice
 - Use of descriptive language
- **Grammar & Spelling** (10 Marks)
 - Correct sentence structure
 - Proper punctuation and spelling
- **Presentation** (10 Marks)
 - Neatness and handwriting
 - Proper paragraphing

We encourage all students to actively participate and make the most of this opportunity. Let us support and motivate our young writers to express themselves confidently and creatively.
