Draw and label three of them, like a "chilly pond," "jagged rocks," or "golden sunlight." <p>2. The Number Lab</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● The Big Count: Imagine the animal travels 638 metres in one day.<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Break it down: Show the Place Value (6 hundreds, 3 tens, and 8 ones).○ Expand it: Write it as $600 + 30 + 8$● Number Patterns: If the animal finds 520 seeds today:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ What is 10 more?○ What is 100 less?● Ordering: Write down the weights of three different animals (e.g., 15kg, 450kg, and 82kg).
