This year, the post of **House Prefect** has been discontinued and replaced with the **Class Prefect** system. Each class will have **one Boy Prefect and one Girl Prefect** who will represent their class throughout the academic year. This is an open invitation to all interested students to nominate themselves for the post of **Class Prefect** and demonstrate their leadership potential.

Selection Process

- **Class Prefects:**
The **Class Prefect Election** will be held on **Tuesday, 14th July 2026**. Class Prefects will be elected through class-wise elections conducted in their respective classrooms. Students interested in becoming Class Prefects must prepare and deliver a short speech on the given topic. Following the speeches, all students in the class will cast their votes. Based on the voting results, **one boy and one girl** will be elected as the Class Prefects of their respective class.
- **House Captains and Deputy House Captains:**
The House Captains and Deputy House Captains will be selected by the respective House Masters.



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- **Student Council Election:**

The **Student Council Election** for the posts of **Head Boy, Head Girl, Deputy Head Boy, Deputy Head Girl, Sports Captain (Boy), and Sports Captain (Girl)** will be held on **Monday, 13th July 2026**.

- All nominated candidates for the Student Council will undergo **two rounds of selection**:
- **Round 1:** Debate Competition
- **Round 2:** Solo Speech
- After the successful completion of both rounds, the final voting for the Student Council will be conducted on the same day.
