- Students may use basic stationery such as glue, colours, tape and child-safe scissors.
- Students must maintain a **neat and clean workspace** throughout the competition.



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- The artwork should reflect the student's **own creativity, imagination and ideas**.
- The use of **sharp, hazardous, unhygienic or unsafe materials** is strictly prohibited.
- The decision of the judges will be **final and binding**.
